SPECIALTY SUMMARY (As outlined in the AFOCD)

Advises Wing CC on complaints and Fraud, Waste and Abuse Issues. Directs the Wing CC Inspection Program (CCIP). Specifically: Validates and verifies Wing Self Assessment Program results; Independently assesses Wing effectiveness with an accountable, structured Wg/CC inspection program; Create and maintain a CCIP dashboard for the Wg/CC; Notifies Wg/CC of discrepancies identified by subordinate organizations requiring external assistance; Runs the Commander's Inspection Management Board; Approves/publishes inspection reports. Assists MAJCOM/HHQ with urgent data queries, including Special and Command Interest Items

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS

-Knowledge of the Air Force readiness/compliance objectives, leadership and management concepts and their relationship to mission accomplishment is mandatory.

EDUCATION: For entry into this SDI, a Master's degree in management; industrial management, education, psychology; criminal justice, public administration, or business administration with a major in management is desirable.

EXPERIENCE: Previous IG and command experience at the unit, wing or MAJCOM is highly desirable
